Level 3 Lesson Distribution: Based on feedback from our families, Level 3 lesson materials will be distributed via student email accounts on Sunday afternoons at 4:00p. This will assist in prepping for Monday morning at a time that works best for your family.

Phishing Attacks: Be aware that “phishing” attacks that are taking place in the K12 community. Since your students are accessing Level 3 programming through school accounts, this is important for our families and students.

With remote meetings becoming more popular and essential, hackers are using fake meeting emails and calendar events to get you to believe you have a meeting and then download what you may think is the video connection software but is malware.

Here are some things to look for before you accept meeting requests:

When you receive an invite, please look at the email address to be sure you recognize it.

Make sure it is from the actual sender’s email address (teacherfirstname.teacherlastname@odyssey.k12.de.us), not one that is spoofed (i.e., myteachersnameodyssey@gmail.com).

Hover over the links, you will be able to see where the link may take you.

Make sure you never give out a password.

If in doubt, do not click. Send out new email to the individual and see if they actually sent it.
