

## **Citizen Budget Oversight Committee Minutes**

## February 19, 2020

Meeting began at 6:04 p.m. Minutes from January 15, 2020 were not available for review. January minutes are to be reviewed at the March 18<sup>th</sup> meeting.

# Financials for January were reviewed:

#### Revenue:

- Preliminary Budgeted revenues are \$31,306,262.
- Revenues collected to date are \$30,542,432, 97.56% of total budgeted revenues.
- Local funds from Christina School District were received.
- Security deposit and 1 month rent received for lease of St. Thomas building.

# Expenses:

- The preliminary budgeted expenses are \$28,869,421 (including contingency)
- Expenses to date are \$18,511,073 and encumbrances of \$233,333, 64.93% of the budget.
- The Amazon charge of \$4,319.94 dated 11/20/2019 has been fully reconciled with receipts and all are proper.

The CBOC will review the detailed school tab in the spreadsheet at the March 18<sup>th</sup> meeting.
