## **Review of October Financials**


Significant expense items that could go over budget were highlighted in yellow:

Ricardo will research the full year budget surplus on the monthly financial statements should agree to the preliminary budget surplus.

## **Investor's Meeting update**

Investors are still holding \$1.4 million in escrow and do not encourage any further indebtedness. Investors would like to see at least one year of successful management of the operational budget and ongoing management of funds to ensure efficiencies and OCS can meet their targeted cash surplus.



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Management has created a 7 or 8 member working group composed of 3 board members and 2 administrators plus representatives of Innovative Schools and Peter Svahn, financial consultant to OCS board.
