OCHI DAY!

October 28th, also known as "Ochi Day", is celebrated in Greece as a National Holiday.

In 1940 the Italians, under the dictator Benito Mussolini, issued an ultimatum to the Greeks, demanding they allow the Italian Army to cross into and occupy Greece. Greece responded with a resounding Ochi!, which means 'no'. The Greeks then sent their army to the Albanian border and pushed the Italian army back beyond the mountains. It was a magnificent victory, the first Allied success of World War II, and the one that prompted Winston Churchill's famous comment: "Until now we used to say that the Greeks fight like heroes. Now we shall say: The heroes fight like Greeks."

Greece's victory affected the outcome of WWII and even today is an inspiration for people of all nations who cherish freedom


