Odyssey Charter School Required Health Forms (For Kindergarten and New Enterers)

Physical exam: The exam must be dated after August 31, 2018. If you have a physical scheduled in August/September, please send us proof of the appointment (e.g. Copy of the appointment card or letter from the physician). It is highly recommended that you make a copy for your own records.
Complete record of immunizations: You may send a copy from your physician's office or fill out the immunization form on the bottom half of the Delaware School Physical Exam. Immunizations <u>must</u> be up to date to prevent school exclusion.
Tuberculosis testing/screening documentation: All new enterers shall have a tuberculosis risk assessment and if needed a mantoux tuberculin skins test <u>within the 12 months</u> of school entry. (New enterer is anyone entering the Delaware public school system for the first time). For any student transferring from a Delaware public school, a new PPD or risk assessment is not needed, however, results of the last test/screen must be documented.
Lead screening: Requirement for all students entering kindergarten.
Emergency Treatment Card: This will be sent home at a later date. Both front and back must be filled out and signed. Please remember check off permission for medication administration.
