

 - Head of School Report, Elias Pappas 90 Day Plan
 - Create consensus RE: reopening of school, Covid testing, and starting 1/19
 - Covid testing for staff and students as of 1/12
 - a. 90% of all OCS staff tested
 - b. 97% of attending students tested
 - ~50% of students are planning to return for in person instruction
 - Establish OCS as a certified Covid testing center
 - Working on testing protocol going forward
 - a. Most likely every 2-3 weeks, or more often if required
 - o Establish relationships with stakeholders, staff and board
 - Meeting with board members, 73% have met one on one
 - Meeting with DE&I, food services, deans, Spec Ed, community and others
 - o Conduct initial professional development, set vision of OCS, and define values
 - Coffee and chats, and professional development with staff
 - a. 95% participation with online activities
 - b. Produced Back to School video
 - Update on high school college application status and success rate
 - 67% of Seniors applying to at least 1 school
 - 83% of applicants have been accepted to at least 1 school



- Greek Program Dr. Marina Mattheoudakis
 - o Two students chose to sit the Ellinomatheia Exam in October, and passed
 - o The 7th and 8th grades began collaborating with students in Athens
 - Summer program with Harvard University in Greece. High school students can begin applying Feb 1st. One student each year has enjoyed this opportunity
 - o Greece's Bicentennial is this year, we are putting together events celebrate Greek independence, and what independence means for our multi-cultural community

 - o Focus on reopening and building #23 retrofit
 - Three bus leases are ending and would like to convert to a purchase agreement
