- o Back to School Bash and opening of Lower School August 19th 4-7
- Thanks to the PTO for covering the cost of the playground equipment
- Orientation sessions will touch on introducing the culture of our school for the new students

o Lower School

- Transformation of 26: Painting, technology, signage, furniture, and so much more.
- All staff positions have been filled, except a long-term substitute and reading specialists.

- Eleventh grader, Rueben Busick-White has been selected for the Bundestag Youth Exchange program, and will spend this year in Germany
 Enrollment Update
 - We continue to register new students for the coming year. Over 2,000 students enrolled, and about 140 additional pending.

Curriculum Instruction and Assessment

- Summer placement tests have been completed
- Instructional resources are being ordered
- Scheduling is nearly complete
- K-5 Reading Pilot will compare the new Amplify program with our current curriculum throughout the year.

Transportation

- Delivery of our four new busses has been pushed to next week
- We are looking for additional busses and spare parts to avoid downtime
- We will run routes for Charter School of New Castle and other after school programs for area private schools
- Bus route emails will go out early next week with bus number and stop details

Student Services

- ELL is reviewing all surveys for screening
- CIA and Student services will review data to help problem solving
- New K-3 reading specialist to be hired
- Working on special education training for our staff
- Special Ed student scheduling is being reviewed
- Hiring five new secondary special ed teachers for this school year

Information Technology

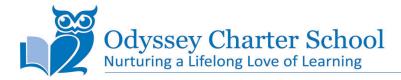
- Building 26 is ready with wifi, projectors, smart boards, paging, and phones.

Facilities

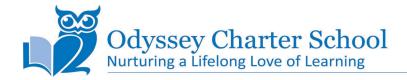
- Building 26 is ready

 - All front doors laminate will be installed next week
 - o ALICE safety training will be September 16th for 6-12 and Oct 7th for K-5

- Greek Program Dr. Ioanna Lekkakou
 - o The Greek Program will have 6 new classrooms in the lower school
 - o There will be 2 new cohorts in 1st grade immersion
 - o Translation of the 5th grade immersion and FLES program is nearly complete
 - o All Greek program staff attended a DEO training session Aug 1-5
 - o The PTO purchased ~160 Greek books from Greece for this year for The Book Fair
 - All Greek program positions have been filled

 - Accounting audit is being completed for Sept meeting
 - Monthly finance report July
 - o Final budget revenues of \$41,376,294, with 53.5% collected
 - Funds are loading as expected
 - o Bus purchases have been finalized before rate increase
 - o Additional used bus has been identified for possible purchase

 - o Looking for parent volunteers to review financials


