
- Hiring & Human Resources

 - ML screening has been completed for students K-12, with approximately 350 students to receive MLL services
 - MTSS monthly problem solving team meetings have begun and will review students' needs and problem solve to best support students
 - WIN (what I need now) is time in each school for students to work on remedial or enrichment skills
 - Mid-year benchmark screening will take place starting 1/22 with interventionist focused on K-3

- Beginning in January IT will offer classes on various software systems used by school staff


\circ Facilities

- Year end audit is wrapping up and will review findings and make adjustments

 - Work on the CRM database and expressing gratitude to previous donors will continue
 - o Capital campaign will launch in February
- Greek Program Ioanna Lekkakou
 - We are beginning a collaboration with the Europa University of Cyprus and OCS students could study there in English while living in the Greek language, a BA in computer science would cost \$9,000 for tuition
 - o Seniors and juniors received a presentation on EUC
