 - o Sustained Excellence in Programming
 - Walkthroughs continue, new committee to support SBAC prep initiative in grade 3-8 to begin after Feb 16th when the interim data is reviewed
 - All 3-8 students will take the comprehensive smarter balanced practices tests in the next 2 weeks. This data will help up improve the readiness of our students.

- Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment (CIA)
 - SEL curriculum, Character Strong, is rolling out for K-5, and the middle school is looking at the 6-8 program
 - CIA team walkthrough and coaching cycles are being completed and the work on driving improvement will continue
 - DDOE will conduct visits with our admin during Feb to assist with the new teacher evaluation system DTGSS
 - Assessment calendar is underway
 - Professional development will be Feb 16th CharterCon at DelState, the themed around equity, diversity, resiliency, and community. Some of our staff will be presenting.






- The annual appeal letters are ready to be sent toward the end of February

- Greek Program Ioanna Lekkakou
 - Greek program committee met and discussed the model of the programs both immersion and fles. We manage to keep our immersion programming to 50% Greek, which is the only immersion school in the state to do so.



- We are working on an event to celebrate and showcase the immersion program to the non-immersion families of OCS. This will include food, student performances, and presentations in March.
- Ellinomatheia Diploma Ceremony will be Feb 21, celebrating the success of our 41 students who completed the exams
- International Greek Language Day, Feb 9th all Greek Language teachers will celebrate the day with special events. Our students will live interview Panagiotis Rappas, a Hollywood animator and artist who lives and works in Greece.
